Under this agreement, the author(s) assign their copyright to the Work to FIRE – Fiscal Relations Research Group, Faculty of Law, University of Copenhagen (the publisher) on the conditions set out below:

1 Original copyright ownership and conditions

In consideration of the publication of the article, the author(s) hereby warrant(s) the following:

- 1.1. All persons who have a reasonable claim to authorship of the Work are named in the manuscript as co-authors, including yourself, and you have not fabricated or misappropriated anyone's identity, including your own;
- 1.2. The author(s) have full power and authority to enter into this agreement and to grant the rights herein granted;
- 1.3. The Work is an original work of the author(s), and publication of the Work in accordance with this agreement does not infringe any intellectual property rights or contractual rights of any other person;
- 1.4. The Work has not previously been published and neither is currently submitted to, nor is under consideration, by other journals, nor have any rights in or with respect to the Work been granted, assigned, or transferred to third parties;
- 1.5. The Work does not invade the privacy rights of any third person, or contain any matter that is libellous, defamatory, obscene, fraudulent or otherwise in contravention of the rights of any third person, nor is in any other way unlawful or in violation of applicable laws;
- 1.6. Original research reported in the Work that has been conducted by the author(s), has been conducted in an ethical and responsible manner, in full compliance with all relevant codes of conduct and legislation;
- 1.7. The author(s) acknowledge all sources of research funding as required by their research funders in the manuscript, and disclose any financial interest or benefit they have arising from the direct applications of their research;

2 Assignment of copyright

- 2.1.
